This course contains information and training to prepare students to function as medical assistants through training in ethics, medical terminology, and the preparation of medical forms. In addition, students will gain expertise in the day-to-day functions of the following specialties: ambulatory care, obstetrics and gynecology, pediatrics, out-patient surgery, urology, orthopedics, internal medicine, cardiology, and laboratory.

Students who successfully complete program hours and competencies receive a certificate of completion and are qualified to participate in industry certification and/or licensing requirements essential for seeking employment.

U.S. Department of Labor Job Outlook: Employment of medical assistants is projected to grow 23 percent from 2014 to 2024, much faster than the average for all occupations.
